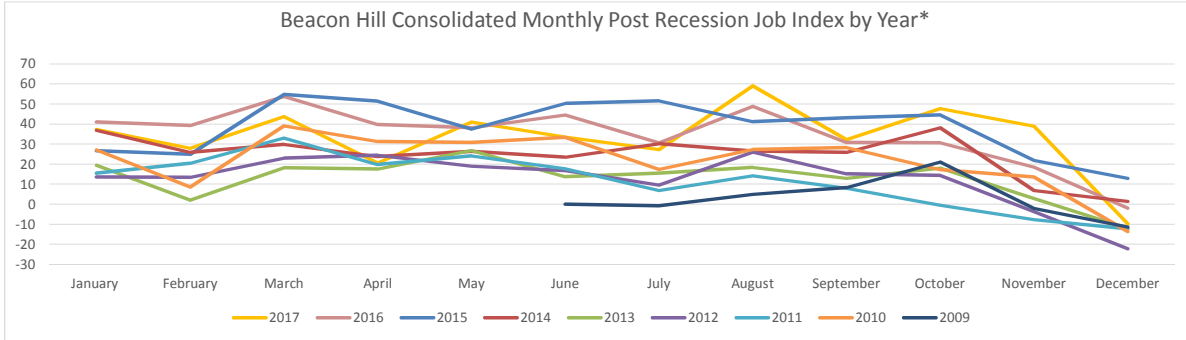

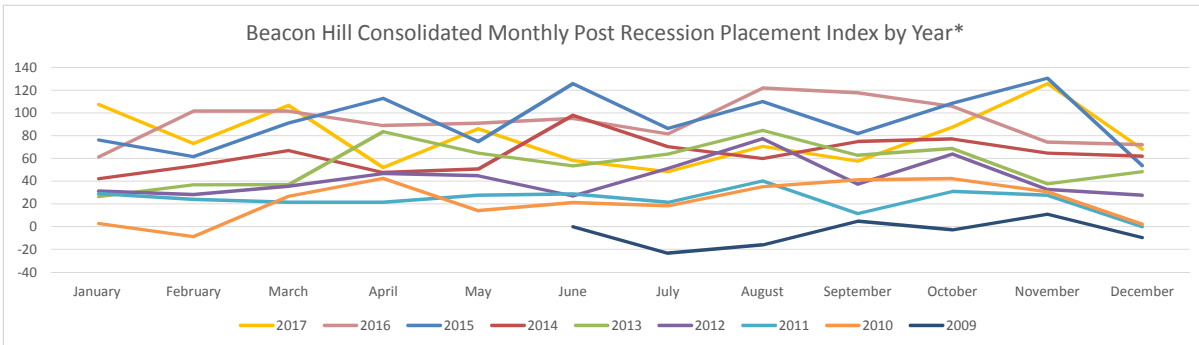

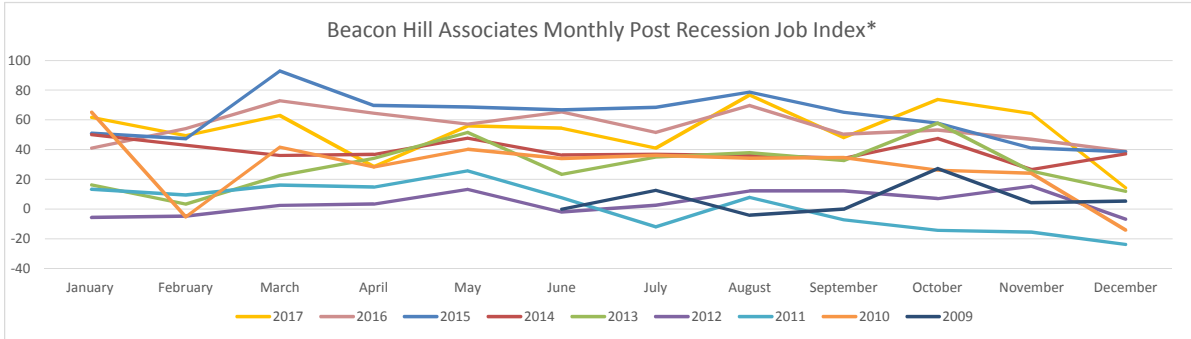
Note: Beacon Hill Pharma is excluded from Index and Wage reporting as no historical data exists due to its recent launch in 2014.
